Live Presentation: approximately 5 minutes

Slides of Presentation due 11:59pm on THURSDAY 4/25/19 to Gradescope (One submission per team)

Your presentation should showcase:

- Project Idea
- Project Design – I/O Devices Used
- Project Design – Communication Used
- Project Design – Original work
- What worked
- What doesn't work
- Highlight process/team related roles

The first 2 slides of your presentation must be:

- Slide 1 MUST BE your Team Number and Team Member Names and NetIDs
- Slide 2 MUST BE your Project Name and Abstract (100 words)

HOWEVER! Do NOT read these first two “intro slides” during your presentation!

Your introduction should be “Hi! We are Team X. Our Project Name is Y.”

Then move onto Slide 3.

Expect each slide to take between 30 seconds to 1 minute of “talk time” during your presentation. So 10 slides (plus the 2 intro slides) is probably too many. Having 5 to 7 slides is probably correct.

Your group must bring your own laptop with your slide presentation ready to go!

This laptop will be connected to a monitor/projector at the start of your presentation.

Your entire group is to arrive at least 20 minutes before your scheduled start time.

Each person will also be required to give feedback on the presentation of one other group.
