- Maybe the homework can be a little easier, also the exam.

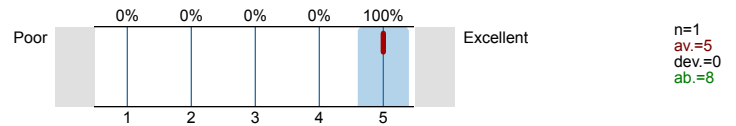
